Lunch

Due to COVID-19, lunch time will look differently than previous years for K-6 students.

Grades K-1 will bring a packed vegetarian lunch from home. Please refrain bringing foods with eggs, onions, garlic, leek, and scallions.

Grades 2-6 will have two options for lunch.

1. Students can bring a food container with lid for a grab and go complimentary vegetarian lunch from the dining hall. No wastage allowed. OR
2. Students can bring a packed vegetarian lunch from home. Please refrain bringing foods with eggs, onions, garlic, leek, and scallions.

Snack

Please send a healthy vegetarian snack for your child. Each grade level will have a separate snack time in the afternoon. Here are some suggestions:

Water bottle

Each student will need to bring a water bottle to school daily.



Student Daily Screener

Immunization/Annual Wellness Check-up

The school is required to report the immunization status of students to the state. Please bring your child to your family health practitioner to receive shots he/she may have missed during the pandemic. If your child has not had his/her annual wellness check-up this year, make sure to schedule one before school starts. Report any new changes to your child's medical records to the school.

Drop off/Pick up Procedures

All parents will drop off and pick up at the curb near the side entrance of the school. Please stay in your cars unless you are helping your child in or out of the car. If you are waiting for an older child, you can park in the parking lot, and the teacher will walk your child to you. Students joining the after school program will be dismissed in the same area.

Authorized Student Pick-Up

If there is a change in who is picking up your child at school, please let the core teacher know or call the office. Make sure that individual is on the Authorized Student Pick-Up form.

- Navy blue, black, or white socks
- Hair accessories in solid colors

5th-6th Grade Girls

- White buttoned down shirt with school logo (short/long sleeve)
- Navy blue & evergreen plaid skirt
- Navy blue pants (winter)
- Navy blue or black leggings
- Navy blue or black knee length socks
- Navy blue, black, or white ankle socks
- Hair accessories in solid colors

Outerwear

- Navy blue cardigan or fleece with school logo
- Navy blue jacket or coat with school logo
